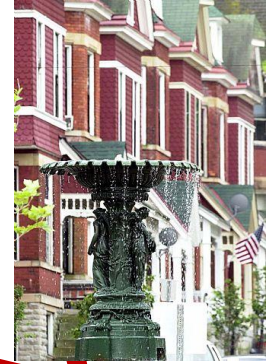

Day 1- Wednesday, October 11

Meal: Lunch & Dinner
