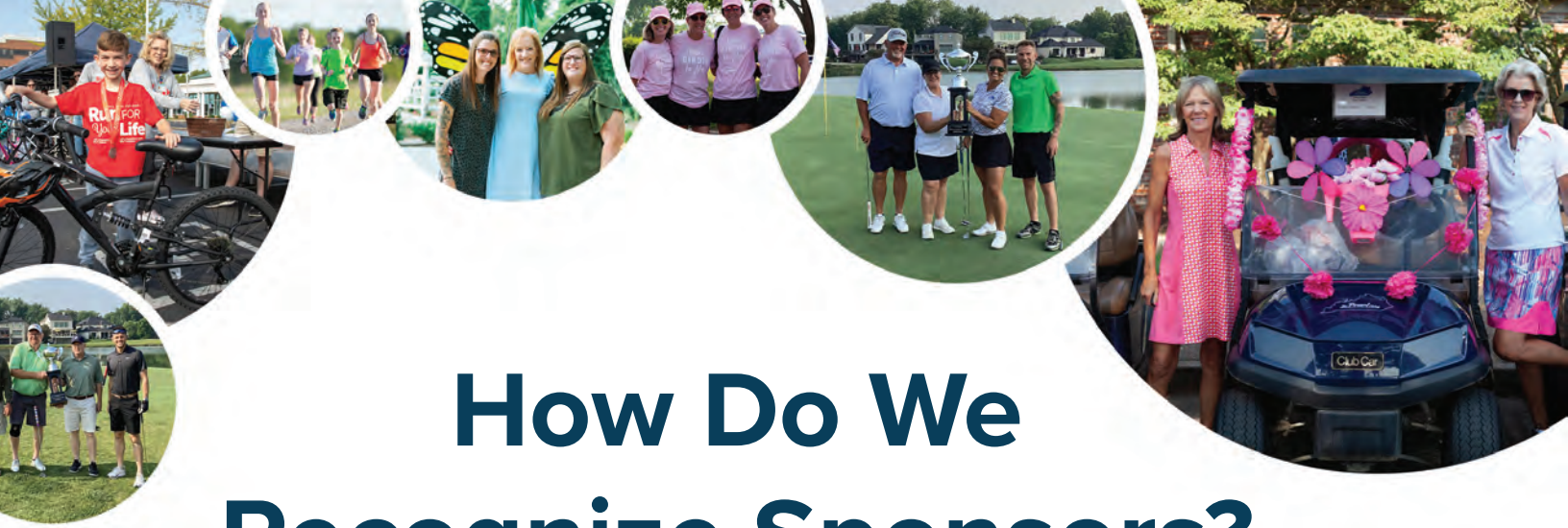

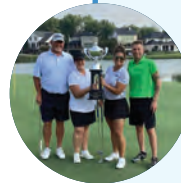

C. Waitman Taylor, Jr. Hospitality Suites

The C. Waitman Taylor, Jr. Hospitality Suites at Owensboro Health Regional Hospital provide a safe, comfortable and relaxed home-like atmosphere for families of patients in the Owensboro Health service area. With 7 suites offering overnight accommodations for families with loved ones requiring extended or intensive care or for those who travel from outside of Daviess County, the Hospitality Suites serve those who need it most.

The suites are one-bedroom units (one of them is a two-bedroom unit), complete with private bath, living area with sofa sleeper, televisions, and kitchenette. There are also laundry facilities, a commons area for dining and relaxation, a game unit for children, and a kitchen service area with complimentary coffee. The suites are located in the Pleasant Valley Medical Office Building, which is attached to the hospital. Families

never have to exit the facility to access the suites or their loved ones.

The suites were made possible by generous contributions from Owensboro Health team members, physicians, and local individuals and businesses. Accommodations are low-cost: \$25 per night (\$35 per night for the double bedroom unit), although NO family is turned away for inability to pay.

The suites are almost always at full capacity, with a waiting list many times. It is a service that is needed and appreciated by all who use it. To insure support for this home-away-from-home, Owensboro Health Foundation welcomes donations of any amount. Contributions are used to provide amenities to families who stay, as well as financial assistance to families who cannot afford to pay for lodging.
