## Suites and Rates

- Four-person, single-bedroom suite: \$25 per night
- Two-person, single-bedroom suite (ADA accessible): \$25 per night
- Six-person, double-bedroom suite (ADA accessible): \$35 per night

## A Home Away from Home

The C. Waitman Taylor, Jr. Hospitality Suites at Owensboro Health Regional Hospital (OHRH) is a place for the loved ones of patients to stay when traveling to and from the hospital is difficult or not possible. Our seven Hospitality Suites offer many of the same features and amenities of a hotel with the added convenience and comfort of being near patients in the hospital.

## Who is eligible to stay in the Hospitality Suites?

Guests at least 18 years old who are visiting an inpatient at OHRH may request a reservation in a Hospitality Suite. All minors must be accompanied by an adult.

Because space is limited, requests for lodging in the Suites are re-evaluated each day based on:

- Condition of the patient
- Participation or involvement of guests in the patient's plan of care
- Guests' distance from home
- Guests' access to transportation
- Financial or other emergent needs of guests

Guests must be visiting patients who are currently receiving inpatient treatment at Owensboro Health Regional Hospital.



## How long can guests stay in the Suites?

Depending on room availability, each room has a five-night maximum stay. Longer stays are at the discretion of Guest Services and require recommendation from the patient's care team.

## Amenities & Services
