


Indiana COVID-19 Data Report

Owensboro Workflow



- 1. Owensboro Health Medical Group Occupational Medicine Owensboro has reduced their hours of access to Monday AND Friday.
- 2. Send workers' compensation injury/illness or occupational medicine patients to Owensboro Health Medical Group Urgent Care Ford outside Monday AND Friday.
- 3. Dr. Rhodes has suspended the performance of Pulmonary Function Tests as a precaution during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 4. Qualitative Fit Testing is still being performed across the system.
- 5. All other occupational medicine access points including Tell City, Henderson, Madisonville, and Powderly are maintaining their current hours and availability.
- 6. Employers using screening services, please email if you have changes to workflow, shifts, or production as we are scheduling screeners a week in advance.
